

## **NOTICE**

With reference to Lokpal of India vacancy circular dated 27/08/2024 regarding engaging Law Clerks on Short term contractual assignment in Lokpal of India, and subsequent application to the said vacancy, it is informed that the candidates at Annexure – ‘A’ have been shortlisted on the basis of the applications received within the due date and the eligibility conditions, for the written test followed by an interview to be held on 08/11/2024, for further consideration of your candidature. The schedule and venue of the examination is as below:

Reporting time	09:30 AM
Written Test	10:00 AM to 01:00 PM (3 hours)
Lunch Break	01:00 PM to 02:00 PM
Venue	Auditorium of Lokpal of India, at 6, Vasant Kunj Institutional Area Phase – II, New Delhi – 110070

The written test will be followed by an interview on the same day i.e. 08/11/2024 (Friday). You are required to bring a filled Admit Card proforma (attached) along-with a self attested photograph which shall be retained after the written test.

### **Pattern of the Examination:**

The selection shall be made on the basis of examination at two successive stages:

#### **First Stage - Written Test consisting of the following components (75 Marks):**

Part-I - Multiple Choice Based Questions, testing the candidates’ ability to understand and apply the law, and comprehension skills; (35 Marks i.e. 70 Multiple Choice questions (MCQs) of 0.5 marks each)

Part II- Theoretical questions relating to preparing a brief synopsis or precis, essay, drafting research memo etc. (40 Marks consisting of 5 Questions)

#### **Second Stage – Interview (25 marks)**

The marks obtained in the above two stages of examination will be taken into account for selection of the candidates.

The First Stage of the examination shall be conducted on the scheduled date and time in physical mode / pen-paper mode at the venue. The questions will be set in English language. The duration of the examination will be 3 hours and there will be no negative marking.
